### Tours for MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, FRIDAY and SUNDAY

Each of these Unst tours includes a visit to Britain's Most Northerly Post Office (closed on Sundays), the Unst Bus Shelter, and Skaw beach.

#### - CUSTOMER'S CHOICE -

If you are the first person to book my tour on your day(s) of choice, you can decide which six attractions from the list below will complete the tour itinerary:

Muckle Flugga Lighthouse (view), Muness Castle, Unst Heritage Centre, Unst Boat Haven, Keen of Hamar, Hermaness Visitor's Centre, Underhoull Broch, Standing Stones, Hagdale Horse Mill, NorNova Knitwear, Valhalla Brewery, Foord's Chocolates, Norwick beach.

Other occasional Unst tour attractions will be The Unst Viking Project, Unst Farmer's Market, Unst Show and Peerie Nights Out. Details will be supplied on request – please call me.

The tour cost is £45 per person, inclusive of lunch and all admission charges.

### Tours for TUESDAY and SATURDAY – 'MUCKLE FLUGGA'

We visit Britain's Most Northerly Post Office, take the Muckle Flugga Boat Trip, then visit Foord's Chocolates, Unst Boat Haven, Hermaness Visitor Centre and the Unst Bus Shelter.

The tour cost is £75 per person, inclusive of lunch, admission charges and boat fare

### The Tour for THURSDAY – 'FETLAR'

We'll see Red-Necked Phalaropes, Red-Throated Divers, Whimbrels, Bobby Tulloch's bird hide, Tresta Beach, the Fetlar Interpretive Centre, eat lunch at the Seaview Café, and then visit Bayanne House and the Fishermen's Memorial at Gloup (both on Yell).

The tour cost is £40 per person, inclusive of lunch and admission charges
